### **EDITORIAL**


#### **Greetings from the Prajatantra Team!**

In the **7th edition of Prajatantra**, Praja Foundation's National Youth Festival, we witnessed remarkable growth in participation and a strong representation of young voices from across India. This year, Prajatantra received an overwhelming response with **3,800+ participants from 674 teams**, representing all **28 states** and **8 union territories**. Out of these, **203 teams qualified for the Semi-Finale Round**. The diverse and enthusiastic engagement of these participants truly embodies the spirit of India's youth and highlights their dedication to driving positive change.

This edition of Prajatantra is being co-organised by Praja Foundation, the National Institute of Urban Affairs (NIUA), and UN-Habitat India, with support from Rohini Nilekani Philanthropies and the Madhu Mehta Foundation, along with VJAL Institute as our Knowledge Partner. This year, we are celebrating the theme of "Artificial Intelligence for Sustainable Cities", inviting youth to imagine, debate, and design the cities of tomorrow—powered by technology and guided by the principles of equity, inclusion, and sustainability.

Participants are encouraged to collaborate and share their vision of a **Model City Government** through competitions such as the **Mayor's Speech**, **Policy Presentations**, **Debates**, and **Quiz**.

We are delighted to announce that the **Qualifying and Semi-Finale Rounds** of Prajatantra 2025 concluded successfully. #### **BOOTCAMP**



#### **KNOWLEDGE SESSION**



1. Knowledge Session on Artificial Intelligence by VJAL Institute:

As part of Prajatantra 2025, a five-day knowledge session was conducted by VJAL Institute, our Knowledge Partner, to participants' understanding strengthen of Artificial Intelligence and its role in shaping sustainable cities. The sessions spanned a wide range of themes—starting with the foundations of AI and generative tools, moving into AI in business and strategic thinking, followed by hands-on experience with AI tools. Critical issues such as ethical AI, data privacy, and responsible use were discussed and the session concluded with discussions on leadership, and final presentations.

These sessions equipped participants with practical insights and tools to envision and design people-centric, Al-powered sustainable cities of the future.

# 2. Knowledge Session on Legislative Structure of City Government and Municipal Finance:

In this session, our expert speaker P.D. Hari Prasad, former Deputy Controller of Accounts at the East Delhi Municipal Corporation, guided participants through the functioning of municipal corporations, the significance of municipal acts, and the processes surrounding municipal elections. He also introduced participants to key aspects of municipal finance, including the fundamentals of city budgeting, revenue sources, and the importance of financial accountability in governance.

The session equipped participants with a strong foundation to understand how urban governance and finance intersect, preparing them for the competitions and discussions ahead in Prajatantra.











### **OPENING CEREMONY**

The Opening Ceremony of Prajatantra 2025, held on 5th September, set the tone for an engaging festival ahead. The event featured keynote speaker Debolina Kundu, Director of the National Institute of Urban Affairs (NIUA), along with guest speakers Parul Agarwala, Country Programme Manager at UN-Habitat India, and Nitai Mehta, Founder and Managing Trustee of Praja Foundation.

The central theme of the discussions revolved around the importance of youth engagement in city governance and their role in shaping sustainable, people-centric urban futures. Speakers also highlighted how emerging technologies such as Artificial Intelligence can support inclusive decision-making and strengthen democratic governance.

The ceremony was followed by the Mayor's Speech Competition, where participants impressed the audience with thoughtful perspectives on the challenges facing their cities, while presenting innovative, future-ready solutions to address them.





### **POLICY PRESENTATION**

We conducted two Policy Presentation competitions: the first on Leveraging Artificial Intelligence (AI) for Municipal Services, and the second on Municipal Finance.





#### Leveraging Artificial Intelligence (AI) for Municipal Services

The Policy Presentation on Leveraging AI for Municipal Services encouraged participants to draft policies exploring how AI can transform everyday governance and service delivery. Acting as subject committees, participants proposed inclusive and ethical frameworks for integrating AI into urban systems to create smarter, people-centric cities.

Ideas put forward included Al-driven platforms for responsive grievance redressal, predictive systems for managing water and waste, and data-driven planning for equitable allocation of resources. The competition highlighted how Al can be used to make governance more transparent, citizen-centric, and efficient, while ensuring that technology remains rooted in inclusivity and accountability. Judges praised the participants for their forward-looking recommendations, which combined technological innovation with democratic values.



#### **Municipal Finance**

The Policy Presentation on Municipal Finance provided a platform for participants to step into the shoes of a city's finance committee and present their vision for strengthening municipal budgets. Participants were tasked with identifying new revenue sources for municipal governments and suggesting ways these could be used to improve the delivery of essential services.

The presentations featured a range of innovative ideas leveraging Artificial Intelligence, including the use of municipal bonds for revenue generation, investments in public transport to reduce congestion and increase revenue, and user-based charges for solid waste management. Judges appreciated the participants' efforts to balance fiscal responsibility with citizen needs, noting that the exercise deepened their understanding of municipal budgeting and financial accountability.

#### POLICY DEBATE

The Policy Debate Competition provided participants with a platform to critically analyze and deliberate on issues related to Artificial Intelligence for Sustainable Cities. Following a format modeled on a Municipal Corporation's General Body Meeting, participants debated the following motion:

**Motion 1:** Should cities rely on traditional fixed-schedule traffic signals for managing traffic flow, **or** should they implement adaptive, Al-driven traffic signal systems for more efficient traffic management?

**Motion 2:** Should cities adopt Al-based platforms for managing citizen complaints to ensure faster resolution and greater accountability? **Or** Should cities maintain traditional complaint management methods to preserve personal accountability, fairness, and nuanced decision-making?

The debates encouraged solution-oriented thinking, with participants defending their positions, responding to questions, and exploring multiple perspectives on technology adoption, ethical considerations, and city development. This competition offered a valuable opportunity for youth to engage in constructive discussions, develop persuasive communication skills, and gain a deeper understanding of how AI can be applied in urban governance to create smarter, more sustainable, and citizen-centric cities.

The Reel Making Competition provided a platform for participants to engage with the theme "Artificial Intelligence for Sustainable Cities" through short-form videos. The competition enabled youth to showcase their ideas on civic participation, urban governance, and citizen engagement in a visually compelling way. Selected entries will now feature in the Grand Finale, highlighting the power of digital storytelling to inspire positive urban change.
