Lokmat News Network Mumbai: A Praja Foundation report has revealed that the police force deployed for the security of Mumbaikars is 30 percent less than the sanctioned posts.

The Mumbai Police Force currently has a strength of 52,000, compared to which only 36,425 policemen are working in the Mumbai Police Force as of July. Due to insufficient manpower, the pressure on the police is increasing. Shocking information has come to light that 773 policemen have died of various diseases in the last five years. 150 policemen have died due to heart disease.

Praja Foundation's report 'Current Status of Police and Law and Order in Mumbai 2023' was published on Thursday. Presently there are many challenges facing law and order in Mumbai, besides there is a huge increase in registered crimes, there is an urgent need to pay attention to this alarming situation, said Yogesh Mishra, Head of Research and Analysis Department of Praja Foundation.

Increase in rape and molestation cases In the last 10 years, i.e. between 2012 and 2022, the reported crimes of rape and molestation have increased by 130 percent and 105 percent respectively. In Rape offenses have increased from 391 to 901 during this period, while molestation offenses have increased from 1137 to 2329 during this period. In the total rape cases registered, 63 percent (615) are rape cases against minor girls. In these cases, cases have been registered under the Protection of Children from Sexual Abuse Act. At the end of 2022, 73 percent of the cases registered under the POCSO Act are pending investigation.

22% reduction in strength even in important postsThere is a 30 percent shortage of manpower in the Mumbai Police Force and 22 percent shortage in important posts like Investigating Police Inspector, Assistant Police Inspector, Police Sub-Inspector. Various diseases have to be faced due to increased stress. In the last five years, 150 people have died due to heart disease, 124 due to corona and 67 due to jaundice and liver disease. Heart disease deaths have increased by 104 percent. 29 people have ended their lives due to various reasons.
