Report Card of MLA by Praja Foundation: Praja

Foundation has released the progress book of MLAs in Mumbai. Congress MLA Amin Patel is at the first position, BJP's Parag Alwani is at the second position, while Shiv Sena's Sunil Prabhu is at the third position. While Shiv Sena's Rabindra Waikar and Prakash Surve, BJP's Mangalprabhat Lodha and Rahul Narvekar have got the lowest marks.

Praja Foundation has brought forward a progress book based on the work done by MLAs in Mumbai in the last two years and the questions raised in the Assembly Hall. This progress book has been prepared for the period from winter session 2019 to monsoon session 2021. This Pragati book has been prepared in relation to the questions raised by 31 MLAs from the people of their constituencies. Five ministers have been excluded.

In 2020, Maharashtra Legislative Assembly functioned for only 18 days due to Covid-19 and the lockdown (after March 24) lasted only four days. Total 19 state assembly proceedings data is available and according to duration of sessions in 2020, Maharashtra state assembly ranks tenth, followed by Karnataka and Rajasthan at first and second positions (31 and 29 days of proceedings respectively)

How have Mumbai MLAs fulfilled their statutory and constitutional responsibilities as representatives of the people? It is evaluated in this Pragati book. The rank of MLA is decided according to their performance

Top 5 Mumbai MLAs with highest marks

- 1)Amin Patel (Congress) 81.43 %
- 2) Parag Alwani (BJP) 79.96 %
- 3) Sunil Prabhu (Shiv Sena) 77.19 %
- 4) Amit Satham (BJP) 75.57 %
- 5) Atul Bhatakhalkar (BJP) 73.61%

Bottom 5 MLAs from Mumbai with lowest marks

- 1) Ravindra Waikar (Shiv Sena) 28.52%
- 2) Prakash Surve (Shiv Sena) 29.76%
- 3) Rahul Narvekar (BJP) 31%
- 4) Mangal Prabhat Lodha 31.49%
- 5) Zeeshan Siddiqui 32.54%

13 out of 31 MLAs from Mumbai have scored 50 percent and above. Also, in terms of attendance, 30 out of 31 MLAs have scored more than 80 percent. Comparing the 2009-10 session and the 2019-20 session, 2019-20 saw a 27 percent increase in MLAs with criminal backgrounds. The number of questions raised in the Legislative Assembly has decreased by 74 percent compared to the previous ten years.
