



## Mumbai: Sexual crimes against women rose 235% from 2012 to 2021

In five years between 2017 and 2021, the city's north central region, which includes the Vile Parle-Bandra-Kurla belt, reported the highest number of crimes.

According to a white paper released by the non-profit group Praja Foundation, registration of rape cases shot up by 235%(from 232 to 777) and molestation cases rose by 172% in Mumbai over a decade from 2012 to 2021, as reported by TOI. The data was an indicator that more women had been coming forward to report these crimes, which was a positive sign, according to experts. Meanwhile, murder cases fell by 27% and theft by 16% over the same period.
