

Srinagar civic body signs MoU with Praja Foundation, Azim Premji Foundation



Srinagar, February 9 (IANS) Srinagar Municipal Corporation (SMC) on Tuesday signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Praja Foundation and Azim Premji Foundation to make urban governance more effective and transform primary school education in Srinagar city.
