The results of a study conducted by the Praja Foundation found that a large number of people lost their jobs due to the coronavirus infection. Unemployment has also increased.

Working as a delivery boy, he quit his job at Signal Power Coved and started this clothing store by borrowing thousands of rupees from people. After looking for a job for several days, he did not get any job and decided to open a shop. Income is lower than before, but it is expected that things will gradually improve

"I have a lot of friends who have been fired and are having trouble driving home," said Signal Power. I'm one of them, I wasn't getting a job, so I started this business right now.

Corona has also had an effect on the copper pocket of dreams. Previously working as a ward boy in a private hospital, the job was done when the contract was over. Now they are working at Covid Center, but the money is less than before 6 people from lesser families depend on them. They don't know how to run the house. Swapnil Tambe said, "Before I used to go home on salary, all the expenses were covered. Now both of them are not able to find out their own expenses or house expenses. There is no work after the lockdown.

A recent study conducted by the Praja Foundation found that 66 percent of the total population had coronary heart disease. 28 per cent of the people have lost their salaries, 25 per cent have worked without pay and 1 per cent have lost their jobs. In December 2020, the Praja Foundation conducted a survey in which they spoke to 20887 families.

Jennifer Spencer of the Tenant Foundation said that "we see that the lowest impact was on lower class workers." Forty-four percent of employees said they had been fired, and 23 percent of all respondents had left the city, with 5 percent saying they had left because they had lost their jobs. '
