Vile Parle, Kurla, Bandra, Chembur see most crime in Mumbai: Praja Foundation report – mumbai information

North-central Mumbai, consisting of areas like Vile Parle, Kurla, Bandra and Chembur, adopted by Jogeshwari, Goregaon, Andheri and Malad, recorded the utmost variety of circumstances in Mumbai in 2019-20, in accordance with a report launched by NGO Praja Foundation on Thursday.

According to the report, 12,865 circumstances have been registered in Vile Parle, Kurla, Bandra and Chembur which included 1,833 circumstances of theft, 580 circumstances of home break-in, 281 circumstances of rape and 40 of homicide.

North-west Mumbai, which constitutes of Jogeshwari, Goregaon, Andheri and Malad, recorded 11,088 circumstances which included 1,435 circumstances of theft, 540 circumstances of home break-in, 251 circumstances of rape and 40 of homicide.

According to the report, homicide circumstances from April 2019 to March 2020 have been highest within the north-east area of Mumbai, together with Bhandup, Vikhroli, Ghatkopar and Govandi. However, this area is reportedly the least variety of prison circumstances with 6,594.

Mumbai Police mentioned that the areas of Bandra and Kurla are essentially the most weak, although the topography and the folks dwelling in them are completely different. "Ironically, cases of rape and theft are highest in Bandra which otherwise is a plush locality," mentioned a police officer. The second-highest area recording extra crimes was north-west Mumbai with 11,088 circumstances.

"Crimes like murder have dropped considerably due to the constant efforts of the police in several parts of the city," mentioned Vishwas Nangre Patil, joint commissioner, legislation and order.

It was additionally noticed within the annual report, that though prison circumstances have been much less in south Mumbai with 7,223, theft circumstances have been third-highest, with 1,110 circumstances after north-central Mumbai, with 1,833 circumstances and north-west Mumbai with 1,435 circumstances.
