

Praja Foundation | Praja Foundation released report card, know which MLAs are on top News WAALI

Mumbai: While in opposition, BJP MLAs have performed well inside and outside the Vidhan Bhavan. It is a different matter that Mumbai BJP President Mangal Prabhat Lodha and Assembly Speaker Rahul Narvekar have been counted among the poor MLAs of Mumbai. Praja Foundation, a social organization that monitors the work of public representatives, has released the report card of the MLAs of Mumbai. In the first place, Congress's Amin Patel has been declared as the number one MLA from Mumbai's Mumbadevi region, while BJP MLA from Vileparle Parag Alwani is in second place and Shiv Sena MLA Sunil Prabhu from Dindoshi is in third place.

Shiv Sena's Ravindra Vaykar, Shiv Sena MLA Prakash Surve and Congress's Jishan Siddiqui, who are part of Shinde faction, have failed to live up to the test of the people. Their names are ranked from one to fifth in order from the bottom. The names of Amit Satam and Atul Bhatkhalkar of BJP are included in the top five.

Out of 36 MLAs, only 31 were placed in the ranking.

Releasing the report card at the Mumbai Press Club, Praja Foundation CEO Milind Mhaske said that out of 36 MLAs from Mumbai, only 31 were placed in the ranking. Congress's Amin Patel got 81.43 and BJP's Parag Alvani got 79.96 percent marks. The marks are given by looking at the quality of questions asked by MLAs, number of questions, attendance, criminal record, corruption, public relations and performance in their own constituency.
